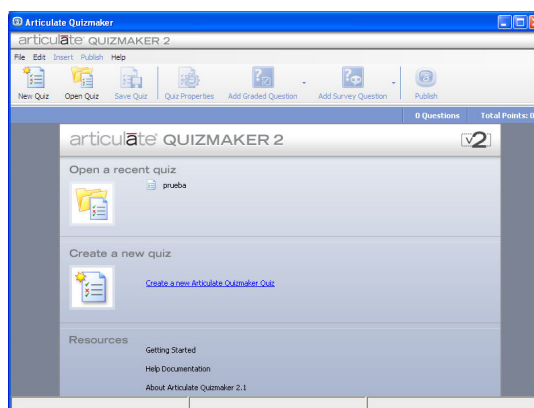
Equipment and software required
